Attendance: New members were introduced. There were 27 members and guest in attendance at tonight's meeting.

Treasurer's Report: The report was read and accepted.

The secretary's report was accepted.

Old business: Andy Elliott reminded the members for the need of additional aircraft for the upcoming Young Eagles event, November 10th. Andy also mentioned that The Grapevine airfield (E 75) is now usable. The campground will be open every third weekend.

New business: Otto Shill reviewed the issues involved in the upcoming hangar inspections at Falcon Field. He will keep the chapter members informed as to the correct fire extinguishers to be used and the various regulations that must be followed to be in compliance with the city fire code.

Safety Topic: Andy Elliott reviewed the topic, "nine ways to die"

Program: President McNeill ran a short video "An introduction to the sonex aircraft". EAA 228 member Tom Nicoud has donated a sonex kit to the chapter. The plan, after we receive 501C3 tax status with the IRS, is to work with the

East Valley Institute of Technology in a mentoring program to build the aircraft on Saturdays with those students that might be interested in such a project. Funds would have to be raised to cover additional costs such as acquiring a suitable engine and instruments. This would be an EVIT after school activity, and would not start until next fall.

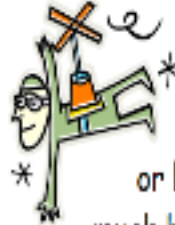
