November 22, 2011

The November meeting of the Falcons was held at the Commemorative Air Force hangar at Falcon Field, Mesa, Arizona.

Chapter President Chris Lucier called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM

Treasurer's Report:

Attendance:

There were 21 members and guests in attendance at tonight's meeting.

Due to the absence of the Secretary, there was no formal vote on the previous meeting minutes, however Steve Shinneman noted that he was taking meeting minutes for 11/22/11.

Young Eagles coordinator Andy Elliott reported that the YE event held on Saturday, November 5, resulted in 69 kids being flown between 8 and noon. There is currently no YE event scheduled for December. There was a discussion about the deductibility of YE expenses.

Chapter socials will resume on the 2nd Saturday in January.

Chapter President Chris Lucier reported that there will be a link to pay annual dues via PayPal on the website.

Chris noted that the next event would be the chapter Christmas Party will be held at the Painted Mountain Golf Resort (Formerly Grandview Steak House) on Saturday December 10th from 6PM - 9PM. Cash Bar will begin at 6:00PM and Dinner will be served at 7:00PM.

Chris reported that the January or February meeting might be at Gary Christiansen's hangar. Details to follow.

Chris reported that the chapter by-laws and articles of incorporation have been changed and amended. They will be posted on the website for member review. The chapter 501.3c status will be filed in January which will allow EAA 228 to accept tax free donations.

Chris mentioned that IBM has a competition for 5-\$100K grants for a teen building program. He thinks the chapter should compete and if successful, could buy and construct an LSA plane with the goal of establishing a flying club. He also noted that Mesa Public Schools are starting an aviation related curriculum.

The presentation was centered around a preflight risk assessment checklist designed for pilots to rate themselves and to make them aware of factors involved in flight planning such as weather, pilot physiology, route of flight, currency, etc.
