The November meeting of the Falcons was held at the Commemorative Air Force hangar at Falcon Field, Mesa, Arizona.

The meeting was opened by president McNeill at 7:05 PM. There were 30 in attendance. The treasurer's report was read and accepted. We currently have \$1885.80 in our account. The secretary's report was accepted as written in the last newsletter.

Young Eagles report from Andy Elliott: The November 10th event was a success with 59 youth and 12 adults given rides. The next event will be in the spring at the Falcon Field open house.

Safety Brief from Andy Elliott: Topic Cold Weather Ops. Andy covered the following topics in his presentation. For this winters flying: Be prepared, Dress warmly, Be prepared to survive a forced landing. Get your airplane ready, Preflight carefully, Take pity on your engine, Take care when taxiing, Icing is deadly and unpredictable, Don't overestimate the capabilities of non-certified aircraft, Remember limitations of certified aircraft, and be realistic about escape routes.

Jim Timm gave a report on changes in airspace in the greater Phoenix area. Jim also mentioned that Luke Air Base would again host an open house next year.

Rick Ruland gave a report on the 2012 Copperstate Fly In. He reviewed the rules on what hours the volunteers need to work in order to receive free passes next year. He called for anyone interested in getting involved in Copperstate to contact him.

Old Business: The airport has offered the chapter free storage of our chapter supplies and equipment. A vote was taken and accepted to use the airport storage area.

New Business: A call was made by president McNeill for someone to step forward to accept the positions of president, vice president and chapter director. Todd Nuttall volunteered to be the new president, Gary Hertzler, vice president and Gordon Craig accepted the position of the new director.

## **We Are Looking For a Few Good Men or Women**

When: Next year's Copperstate fly-in. (2013)

Where: Casa Grande Airport

Minimum time commitment: 4 to 5 hours on any one day

Volunteer Job Description: Camp ground, Handicapped and Vendor Admissions Assistant

**Responsibility:** Be on station continuously with part time assistant at the east side gate leading to the camp ground, vendor and handicapped parking areas. Direct all traffic to stop, collect fees for camping and admissions, have customer register on the registration sheet, provide car/ camper passes and programs, give verbal instruction on where to proceed, and smile. At end of duty period, provide cash and record of cash receipts to roving cash manager. Receive and read e-mails regarding detailed instructions for normal and abnormal procedures. Be on time for assigned duty period.

**Amenities:** You will be based at a camper location on the intersecting runway at Casa Grande airport, adjacent to the aircraft camper location. The camper has a shade and a cooler for drinks. Water will be supplied on a regular basis, and potty breaks are available when the assistant is on site. Free breakfast, lunch and dinner is available before or after the assigned hours at the terminal building, provided that you show your volunteer wrist band. An onsite lunch can be provide upon special request with the Camp Ground Host Director. This may be necessary during busy registration periods. Your wrist band also allows you admission to the event on all three days. If you fly in, we can probably get you a parking slot close to the camper.

A time slot should be indicated as Thursday morning, Thursday afternoon, or Friday morning etc. or all day Thursday etc. A final list will be prepared in late September 2013.
